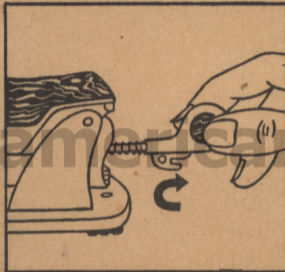
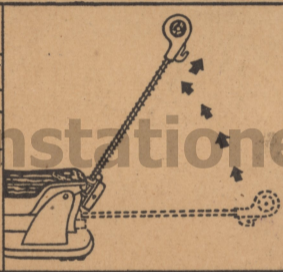


HOW TO LOAD THE ACELINER

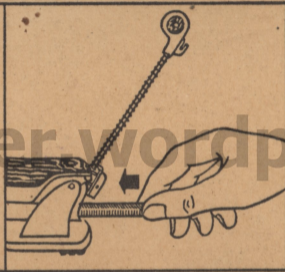
New HAND PLIER Feature
Fits the Hand Perfectly



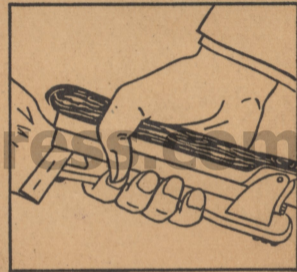
1 Push feeder bar in and raise up to release lock.



2 Slide feeder bar out and swing up — slight pull at top will hold it there.



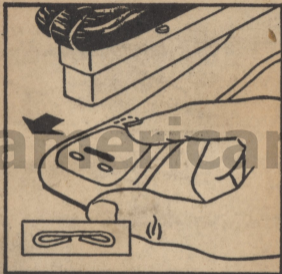
3 Fully insert Aceliner Staples No. 2025 — swing feeder bar slightly forward, press down, lower to horizontal position and insert to lock.



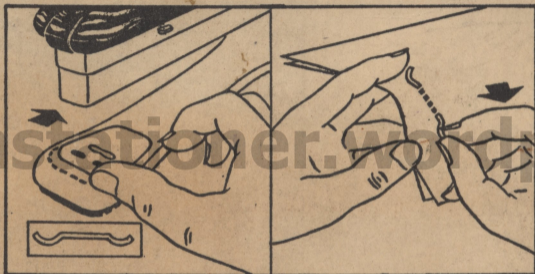
Useful in many ways as a hand plier, for clipping papers, sealing bags, etc.

IT STAPLES---IT PINS---by *sliding ANVIL:*

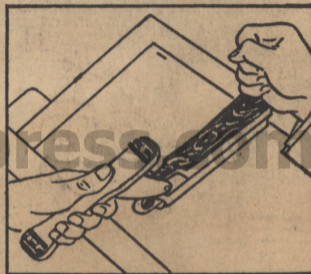
IT TACKS



1 Slide ANVIL forward to make a permanent stitch for secure fastening.



2 Slide ANVIL backward to make a temporary stitch, which can be removed as easily as a pin. See above illustration.



Swing back the base as shown for tacking. Ideal for fastening labels to boxes; bulletins and drawings to boards; shelf-paper; tiebacks, screens, etc.
